**Intelligent Tutoring Systems** Beverly Woolf 2008-07-08 The 9th International Conference on Intelligent Tutoring Systems (ITS2008) was held June 23-27, 2008 in Montreal. This year we celebrated the 20th anniversary of the conference founded in 1988 in Montreal. We have had biennial conferences for most of the past 10 years around the world, including in Brazil, Taiwan, France, Canada, and the USA. These ITS conferences provide a forum for the interchange of ideas in all areas of computer science and human learning, a unique environment to exchange ideas and support new developments relevant for the future. The 2008 conference was a symbolic milestone that enabled us to look back at what has been achieved and what is currently being done, in order to face the challenges of tomorrow. Much has changed in the last 20 years in terms of hardware, software, programmers, and education stakeholders. Technology is now networked, pervasive, and available anyplace and anytime. The potential exists to provide customized, ubiquitous guidance and instruction. However, much has remained the same and the need is just as great to model the learner, teaching strategies and domain knowledge. This year we saw an increase in research into student affect (motivation, boredom, and frustration), specifically attempts to detect student affect, while feedback studies considered which responses to provide given both student cognition and affect. Studies also looked at the impact on learning of positive feedback and politeness in feedback. New research was seen in data mining based on larger studies that use data from real students to diagnose effective learning and teaching. So much interest has been generated in this area that the 7th International Conference on Educational Data Mining was co-located with ITS 2008.
