How to Use the Fishbone Tool for Root Cause Analysis

Overview: Root cause analysis is a structured team process that assists in identifying underlying factors or causes of an adverse event or near-miss. Understanding the contributing factors or causes of a system failure can help develop actions that sustain the correction. A cause and effect diagram, often called a "fishbone" diagram, can help in brainstorming to identify ...
